# Sidera Environmental, Inc

The Industrial Activities Storm Water General Permit requires the development and implementation of a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and Best Management Practices (BMPs) for facilities that have obtained coverage under the General Permit. The SWPPP must be readily available upon request for review by representatives of the Regional Water Quality Control Board, and the local municipal storm water management agency.

The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) has two major objectives:

- (a) To identify and evaluate sources of pollutants associated with industrial activities that may affect the quality of storm water discharges and authorized non-storm water discharges from the facility, and
- (b) To identify and implement site-specific Best Management Practices (BMPs) to reduce or prevent pollutants associated with industrial activities in storm water discharges and authorized non-storm water discharges.

The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) shall include site-specific descriptions of the industrial activities conducted at the facility, the potential pollutant sources from each activity and the descriptions of Best Management Practices (BMPs) recommended for each activity.

The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) shall include: (1) A list of significant materials handled and stored at the facility with the locations where the material is being stored as well as the typical quantities and frequency, (2) A description of the facility's industrial activities, associated potential pollutants that could be discharged in storm water discharges or authorized non-storm water discharges, (3) An assessment of all industrial activities and potential pollutant sources and (4) A description of the storm water Best Management Practices (BMPs) implemented at the facility for each potential pollutant and it's source.
