



The Visual Observations of Storm Water Discharges are required each month of the Wet Season (October 1 to May 31) during each Permit Year, in months with storm events that produce discharge from the facility and included in the Annual Report. The visual observations must be conducted during the first hour of discharge at all discharge locations. Visual observations are only required of storm water discharges that occur during daylight hours, during scheduled facility operating hours and are preceded by at least three (3) working days of dry weather.

Please record any eligible storm events that do not result in storm water discharge to the drain inlets or discharge locations of the facility. If no storm events occur that produce discharge during the month, enter No Storm Water Discharge.

The visual observations shall describe the SWDs characteristics, which include whether the discharge:

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1. Was clear or cloudy.
 2. Was discolored.
 3. Was causing staining.
 4. Contained floating objects.
 5. Had an oil sheen.
 6. Had odors, etc.

Record your visual observations during one storm event each month of the Wet Season and whether pollutants were observed at any of the discharge locations. If yes, describe on reverse side the drainage area, discharge characteristics and revised or new BMPs and date of implementation.
